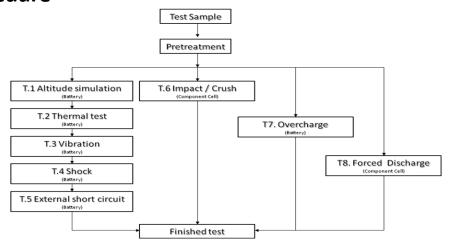

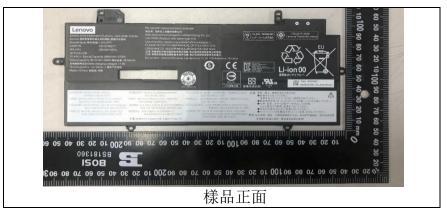

T2:Thermal test  This test assesses cell and battery seal integrity and internal electrical connections. The test is conducted using rapid and extreme temperature changes.  Test cells and batteries are to be stored for at least six hours at a test temperature equal to 72±2°C, followed by storage for at least six hours at a test temperature equal to 72±2°C, followed by storage for at least six hours at a test temperature equal to 70±2°C. The maximum time interval between test temperature extremes is 30 minutes.
